Marketing — 45 Skills

One pack from creator Corey Haines ([coreyhaines31/marketingskills](#) on GitHub) covers everything from ad creative variations to landing page copy. Install the whole pack, then start with three skills before touching the rest.

QUICK TIPS

- Start with: ad-creative, copywriting, cro (conversion rate optimization)
- Once you're comfortable, explore: marketing-plan, lead-magnets, programmatic-seo

Social Media — 17 Skills

Charlie Hills' pack ([charlie947/social-media-skills](#)) turns Claude into a content strategist. Run voice-builder before anything else — it interviews you about your brand and writes two reference files every other skill in the pack reads from.

QUICK TIPS

- Run voice-builder first, always
- reels-scripting studies your best-performing videos and reverse-engineers the pattern
- youtube-thumbnail generates thumbnail concepts and text

Design — 2 Packs

Two community packs cover visual work without the flat, 'obviously AI' look: a UI/UX pack for product and web design, and a taste-focused pack for general visual judgment.

QUICK TIPS

- Feed it your brand tokens first: hex codes, fonts, spacing, corner-radius values
- Use it for one real deliverable before judging the pack — the first output is always the roughest

Finance — 8 Skills

Anthropic's own finance pack (from anthropics/knowledge-work-plugins) handles reporting work that used to need a bookkeeper. Commands are namespaced, so you'll type `/finance:skill-name` instead of the skill name alone.

💡 QUICK TIPS

- `financial-statements` builds P&L, balance sheet, and cash flow with flux analysis
- `variance-analysis` breaks results into price vs. volume
- `reconciliation` automates bank matching

Legal — 9 Skills

Also from Anthropic, this pack reads contracts and briefs the way a first-pass associate would — fast, but not a replacement for your lawyer on anything that actually matters.

💡 QUICK TIPS

- `review-contract` flags clauses against your own accepted/negotiable/rejected terms
- `triage-nda` gives you a rapid read before you sign anything
- Set your jurisdiction and risk thresholds before running it on a real document
